Hayle Harbour - This colourful photo of the harbour which is just a 10 minute walk from our Hayle office was originally known as Hayle Port (Heyl Porth) and is part of Cornwall and West Devon Mining Landscape's World Heritage site.



Wheal Coates - Perhaps one of Cornwall's most recognisable Wheal houses, National Trust St Agnes Head, located on the St Agnes Beacon is just a short drive from the Churchtown Square and our St Agnes office.



Redruth Mining Statute & Carn Brea monument - Proudly looking over Redruth high-street the Mining Man statue, first erected in 2008, is just a few minutes walk from our Head office off the bottom of Redruth high-street. The iconic Carn Brea monument representing our far reach into the surrounding local area. A old Cornish tale also links the Carn to St Agnes Beacon: The old Gaint Bolster who used to terrorise the St Agnes Village would stand with one foot atop the beacon and his other on Carn Brea, 7 miles apart! Some even say the strange formations in the rocks on top of Carn brea are from his hands.
