It's natural to think about what might happen if we are unable to deal with our affairs.

A lasting power of attorney is a way to give the legal power to someone (or more than one person) to deal with your affairs. There are two sorts

- A Property and Financial Affairs Power of Attorney grants powers to deal with your property, your bank accounts and other financial assets. It may be used as soon as it is registered.
- A Health and Welfare Power of Attorney grants powers to assist you with your personal affairs, daily care routines and decisions through to your continuing medical treatment and when / if you may be artificially resuscitated. These LPAs only come into force when you lose the capacity to make decisions

You can have either or both powers of attorney and you can, but you don't need to, have the same person or people acting as your attorney in both cases.
